Tickets are non-refundable. If you are unable to use them, you are welcome to post a sign on the bulletin board to sell them.

All performers other than Preschool students involved in Barnyard Tailz are to arrive through the south backstage door 1/2 hour prior to the scheduled start time of the act they are performing in.

If a dancer is in the audience watching, they can come backstage during the intermission prior to the act they are performing in. For example if they are in Act II and are watching Act I in the audience, they can come backstage during intermission.

Dancers will remain backstage for the entire act that they are performing in.

Dressing rooms will be assigned to the dancers.

Recital Finale Costume

The finale is to the song "Don't Stop Believing" and is taught during the last few weeks of classes. It is performed at the end of Act III. All students are invited to stay and perform in this routine.

If students are given a special section of the finale they are to wear a black tanksuit and black shorts or black pants (to be confirmed by your teacher). All other students that come onstage to sing the end part of the finale can wear their dance costume.

More Recital Information

- Make sure your name is in all your costume pieces and shoes.
- Do not keep valuables backstage. We will not be responsible for lost items.
- It's a good idea to keep your costume pieces in a file box with your name on it. Great for young students to decorate their costume box!
- For security reasons, please limit the number of parents, siblings, etc. backstage. It would be greatly appreciated if only one parent went backstage with the student.
- There will be a male dressing room.
- Please remember that there are students changing in dressing rooms. Therefore, we ask that no males go into the female dressing rooms.
- There will be supervisors to assist the younger students with changing costumes in their dressing rooms.
- Hairstyle for Recital
All students other than preschoolers and those told otherwise by their teacher will wear the following hairstyle for recital:
 - Approximately a 4" part on the left side of the head, above the eye
 - Hair pulled back into low bun. Using a hair net to secure the bun makes this hairstyle much easier.
 - It is the same part/style as the studio hairstyle demonstrated on our website, except that the hair is to be in a bun rather than a ponytail.
